Faculty will be compensated for finishing course 1 (\$250) and course 2 (\$500) at the conclusion of the upcoming regular semester. Furthermore, in the second year, they will receive compensation for completing course 3 (\$750) and course 4 (\$1000) after the conclusion of the subsequent regular semester.
